## Autumn Term

EYFS

### Understanding the World

We will be learning about our bodies, and the things that make us unique.

We will learn about the 5 senses.

We will learn about our families, and different types of family.

We will be learning about different celebrations around the world, including Diwali and Hannukah.

We will look at changes through the seasons.

### Expressive Arts and Design

Daily, we will encounter opportunities to role play, paint, draw, make music, sing, dance and be imaginative through play, as well as guided activities.

### Memorable events

We will learn about the festival of Diwali with an experience day.

We will perform a nativity in the first week of December for our families to watch!

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will learn about the rules and behavioural expectations in school and why we have them.

We will develop self-confidence and awareness through talking about ourselves and our interests.

We will build positive relationships with our peers and the adults

### Communication and Language

· We will learn appropriate ways to speak to each other, taking turns to speak and to listen.

· We will use language to create roles whilst engaging in role play or small world activities.

We will listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.

### Literacy

We learn to recognise initial sounds and then how to blend those sounds to read simple words in daily Phonics sessions.

We will learn how to write our names.

We will be taking part in 1:1 reading sessions each week with an adult.

Story time will occur daily to develop a love for reading!

### Physical Development

We will learn how to get changed for PE.

We will explore different ways of moving our bodies.

We will learn how to use a writing tool and hold it effectively.

### Mathematics

We will take part in daily Maths sessions, where we will be given opportunities to recognise, order, read and write numerals.

We will explore shape and pattern.

We will also learn to understand numbers and represent these in a variety of ways, whilst practising our counting and reasoning skills.

We will enjoy lots of number rhymes and songs.

During our child initiated time, we will learn to sort objects, follow and create simple patterns and look at and describe basic 2D shapes in the environment.
