This term our topic is:

## The Seaside!

### Phonics

- In phonics, we will continue to learn our set 3 sounds.
- We will be using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our writing. We will start to use conjunctions such as 'and'.
- We will be working on our reading fluency using the 6 P's.

### The Arts

- In art, we will be developing our collage skills when creating a beach landscape in our sketch books.
- D&T has a food focus and we will be making pizzas.
- In music, for a half term we will be learning how to play djembe drums and we will learn about pitch and rhythm for a half

### RE/ Character Education

- In RE we are learning about different places of worship.
- In character education we will look at safe relationships.

### Memorable Events

- We will do lots of outdoor learning, including doing a walk around Witham to look for ways to help save the environment.

### Science

- We will learn about seasonal changes and weather conditions in each season.
- We will also learn about the parts of plants and what they need to grow.

### Maths

- This term we will learn about place value, addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers, learn how to tell the time to the o'clock and half past, learn about position and direction, recap multiplication and division, learn about money and 2D and 3D shapes.

### Computing

- We will be learning about moving a robot and how to command/programme it.
- We will use our programming knowledge to animate a sprite.

### History/Geography

- We will look at how the Seaside has changed since the Victorian times and compare this to our lifetime.
- We will learn about human and physical features of a seaside with a focus on sustainability. We hope to litter pick on our beach trip to promote the importance of saving the Planet.
